

FAYETTEVILLE DAM REMOVAL & STREAM RESTORATION PROJECT

RFQ: Questions/Answers

1. Is the unnamed tributary to EFLMR the receiving stream from the regional WWTP to the east?
 - a. The Fayetteville-Perry WTPP has a sprinkler system and evapotranspiration field. It is assumed the receiving stream receives little discharge, if any. Permit information can be found here: <https://echo.epa.gov/detailed-facility-report?fid=OH0119041&redirect=echo#summary>
2. Are there recent dam safety inspection documents available?
 - a. Yes, a copy can be downloaded from the project website
3. What is the schedule for CE services?
 - a. Ideally CE services could be completed as soon as possible. The project schedule can be negotiated.
4. Is there a budget established for these services?
 - a. Per Ohio Revised Code, public agencies seeking Statements of Qualifications for design services are required to evaluate firms solely on qualifications.
5. Would you be able to provide a kmz of the project boundary for the dam removal project on a tributary that drains directly to the East Fork Little Miami River (EFLMR) in Fayetteville, Ohio?

6. Is the due date for the SOQ still 7/31?
 - a. Yes, the due date remains 7/31/26.
